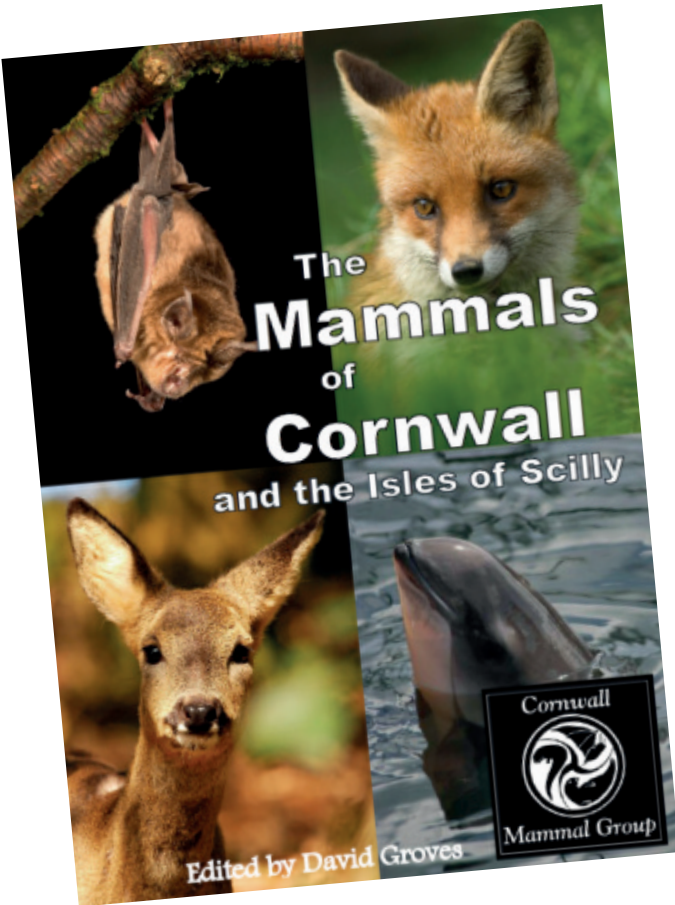


Cornwall's mammal atlas is available now!
